GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 93-4

AN ORDIANANCE VACATING PORTION OF

PLATTED ALLEYWAY AND STREETS

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-20-1-1 et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana after petition, notice and hearing has determined that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described portion of platted roadway be closed and vacated:

Beginning at a point 865 feet South (government marker #8) and 150 feet S 15 - 23' - 29" E of the NE corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 6, T 27 N, R 8 E (also NW corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, T 27 N, R 8 E) Thence South to the Salamonie Dam Road, a distance of approximately 2000 feet.

NOW THERFORE, on petition filed, notice, and after hearing and discussion, after due consideration and review, it is determined by said Wabash County Commissioners as signed hereinafter that the following portion of platted roadway shall be vacated:

Beginning at a point 865 feet South (government marker #8) and 150 feet S 150 - 23' - 29" E of the NE corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 6, T 27 N, R 8 E (also NW corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, T 27 N, R 8 E) Thence South to the Salamonie Dam Road, a distance of approximately 2000 feet.
