AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTION OF
PLATTED ALLEYWAY and STREETS

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-20-1-1 et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana after petition, notice and hearing has determined that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described portion of platted alleyway and streets be closed and vacated:

The ALLEYWAY from Third Street to Fourth Street between lots #14 and #26 & #15, in the original Comstock Plot of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana.

ALSO

RAILROAD STREET from Third Street to Fourth Street between lots #25 & #16 and #24 & #17, in the original Comstock Plot of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana.

ALSO

FOURTH STREET EXTENDED between lots #14 and #11 & #12 & #13, in the original Comstock Plot of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE, on petition filed, notice, and after hearing and discussion, and after due consideration and review, it is determined by said Wabash County Commissioners as signed hereinafter that the following portion of platted streets and alleys shall be vacated:

The ALLEYWAY from Third Street to Fourth Street between lots #14 and #26 & #15, in the original Comstock Plot of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana.

ALSO

RAILROAD STREET from Third Street to Fourth Street between lots #25 & #16 and #24 & #17, in the original Comstock Plot of Liberty Mills, Chester


