

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established a speed zone on County Road 400 West between State Road 16 and State Road 114, wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be 40 miles per hour (40 mph);

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs on County Road 400 West between State Road 16 and State Road 114, the maximum speed limit shall be 40 miles per hour (40 mph).


Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "B" misdemeanor.

PASSED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, on this 6th day of January, 1992.


