

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT  
OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the traffic control signs should be placed at the intersection of Chippewa Street and County Road 700 West (north of Roann at the Covered Bridge), requiring traffic traveling on Chippewa Street to stop for County Road 700 West, thus making County Road 700 West preferential.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on Chippewa Street moving toward the intersection of Chippewa Street and County Road 700 West (north of Roann at the Covered Bridge) will be required to stop, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.


The effect of this Ordinance shall be to create a two-way stop, causing the traffic on Chippewa Street approaching the intersection of Chippewa Street and County Road 700 West (north of Roann at the Chippewa Bridge) to stop before proceeding across or into said intersection, making County Road 700 West preferential at its intersection with Chippewa Street.


Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
