

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTION OF PLATTED ALLEYWAY

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-20-1-1 et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana after petition, notice and hearing has determined that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described portion of platted alley be closed and vacated:

Alleyway between lots #95, #96, #77 and #78, being a distance of 120 feet, more or less, in the original Comstock Plot (Platt) of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana. The area also located as on the northwest and southwest corner of Third Street, between Wall and Wabash Streets.

NOW THEREFORE, on petition filed, notice, and after hearing and discussion, and after due consideration and review, it is determined by said Wabash County Commissioners as signed hereinafter that the following portion of platted alley shall be vacated:


Alleyway between lots #95, #96, #77 and #78, being a distance of 120 feet, more or less, in the original Comstock Plat (Platt) of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana. The area also located as on the northwest and southwest corner of Third Street, between Wall and Wabash Streets.
