GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1991-85-8

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that additional traffic control signs should be placed at the intersection of Lake and Main streets in Laketon, Indiana, thus changing the two way stop intersection to a four way stop intersection.

WHEREAS, in so doing the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County are specifically and intentionally revoking any prior ordinance that established said intersection as a two way stop.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic moving toward the intersection of Lake and Main streets in Laketon, Indiana shall be required to stop, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
