## ORDINANCE OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA

## ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ - 1991

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WABASH COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, IC 13-9.5-2 requires each county in the State of Indiana to either establish itself as a single county solid waste management district or to join with one or more other counties in the formation of a joint solid waste management district; and

WHEREAS, IC 13-9.5-2-5 establishes procedures for the formation of a county district; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Wabash County have agreed that Wabash County can best serve the needs of its citizens with regard to the management of solid waste by forming a County district; and

## NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Wabash County, Indiana does hereby establish a county solid waste management district to be known as the WABASH COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISTRICT ("District"), organized pursuant to IC 13-9.5, to perform all of the functions authorized and directed by said statute, as it is now promulgated or as the same may hereafter be modified. The District shall be controlled by a board of seven (7) members known as the Wabash County Solid Waste District Board of Directors.

SECTION 2. All of the incorporated and unincorporated territory of Wabash County shall be included in the District.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to IC 13-9.5-2, each member of the Board of Commissioners serves as a member of the District Board of Directors, with terms to be coextensive with the member's term of office on the Wabash County Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 4. The Board of Commissioners hereby appoints Ed DeFusco, Town Council Member, Town of North Manches, terrepresent the municipalities in the county other than the largest municipality. The remaining three members shall be appointed as follows:

(1) One member appointed by the Wabash County Council from its membership.

- (2) The Mayor of the City of Wabash.
- (3) One member appointed by the Common Council of the City of Wabash, from its membership.

SECTION 5. All other ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions and the intent of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective from and after June 28, 1991.
