GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2012-85-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE 94-9, THE COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF ANGLING ROAD AND COUNTY ROAD 600 WEST

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance 94-9 to provide for motor vehicles traveling west on Angling Road to stop at Angling Road's intersection with County Road 600 West, and to provide for motor vehicles travelling south on County Road 600 West to stop at County Road 600 West's intersection with Angling Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED THAT GENERAL ORDINANCE 94-4 IS AMENDED TO ADD THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Motor vehicles traveling west on Angling Road shall be required to stop at Angling Road's intersection with County Road 600 West.
- 2. Motor vehicles traveling south on County 600 West shall be required to stop at County Road 600 West's intersection with Angling Road.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
