GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013 -85-11

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2004 WITH REGARD TO FEES CHARGED FOR SERVICES AND RECORDS

Pursuant to IC 16-20-1-27, the Wabash County Board of Health may, subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, establish and collect fees for specific services and records.

On or about October 25, 2004, the Board of Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 4, 2004, an ordinance with regard to fees charges by the Wabash County Board of Health for services and records.

Notwithstanding the provisions of IC 16-20-1-27, Ordinance No. 4, 2004, does not state that such fees are subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners.

Accordingly, Ordinance No. 4, 2004 should be repealed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:

- 1. Ordinance 4, 2004 is repealed and replaced in its entirety with this Ordinance.
- 2. Fees charged by the Wabash County Board of Health for specific services and records are subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana.
- 3. Such fees may not exceed the actual cost of the services and/or records being provided.
- 4. As collected, such fees shall be accounted for and transferred to the Wabash County Health Fund.
