

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 90- 3

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPEED ZONE
AND EXCLUDING SEMI/TRUCK TRAFFIC

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it would be in the best interests of the general public to cause to be established a speed zone on Wabash County Road 400 West, between Indiana State Highways 16 and 114, wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be 45 miles per hour (45 mph); and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that semi and truck traffic should be excluded from the use of this roadway during the period of road construction on State Highway 15;

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs on those portions of Wabash County Road 400 West, between Indiana State Highways 16 and 114, the maximum speed limit shall be 45 miles per hour (45 mph); and no semi or truck traffic will be allowed.


Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a class "B" misdemeanor.
