GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 90-4

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AUDITOR TO

COLLECT PROPERTY ENDORSEMENT FEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code I.C. 32-1-2-37 et. seq. and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it would be in the best interest of county real estate for a service fee to be charged from all persons obtaining and/or receiving a property endorsement from the County Auditor; and

Whereas, the service fee established by the State legislature for said service has been set at \$1.00 for each property endorsement that the Auditor makes; and

Whereas, the fee shall be in addition to any other fee provided by law; and

Whereas, the Auditor shall place the revenue received under this subsection in a dedicated fund to use in maintaining plat books.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the enactment of this ordinance and in accordance with Indiana Statutes as hereintofore stated it is hereby enacted by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. A service fee of \$1.00 shall be charged to all persons obtaining and/or receiving a property endorsement from the County Auditor.
- 2. Said service fee shall be in addition to any other fee provided by law.
- 3. The revenue received under this established ordinance shall be placed in a dedicated fund for use in maintaining plat books.
- 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect commencing July 1, 1990.
