

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 89-IV

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT
OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control signs should be placed at the intersection of Wabash County Road 500 North and County Road 400 West.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic moving toward the intersection of County Road 500 North and County Road 400 West will be required to stop, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to create a four-way stop causing all traffic approaching said intersection of County Road 500 North and County Road 400 West to stop before proceeding across or into said intersection.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
