GENERAL ORDINANCE 89- IA

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING SMOKING IN THE WABASH COUNTY COURTHOUSE, MEMORIAL HALL, and THE WABASH COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 13-1-13-1 through 13-1-13-9 and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, as follows:

- 1. There shall be no smoking, meaning the carrying of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or any other lighted smoking equipment, or the inhalation or exhalation of smoke from any lighted smoking equipment, in any of the offices, courtrooms, conference rooms, storage rooms, restrooms, halls, furnace room, or any other location in the Wabash County Courthouse. The entire Courthouse shall be a non-smoking area.
- 2. Further, there shall be no smoking meaning the carrying of any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or any other lighted smoking equipment, or the inhalation or exhalation of smoke from any lighted smoking equipment, in any of the offices, rooms, halls, or areas of Memorial Hall.
- 3. There shall be no smoking meaning the carrying of any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or any other lighted smoking equipment, or the inhalation or exhalation of smoke from any lighted smoking equipment, in any of the offices, rooms, halls, or areas of the Wabash County Probation Department.
- 4. Any one who violates this ordinance commits a Class C infraction.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect commencing January 1, 1990 and replacing General Ordinance 85-7, hereby revoked effective the same date.
