WABASH COUNTY COUNCIL ORDINANCE 88-1 DESIGNATE FUNDS TO ANIMAL SHELTER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Wabash County Council that according to Indiana Code 15-5-9-8, a county legislative body may designate one (1) humane society located in that county to receive fifty cents (50¢) from each dog tax payment collected by the township trustee under this chapter. A humane society designated shall use the funds disbursed to the society to maintain an animal shelter.

WE, HEREBY DESIGNATE the Wabash County Animal Shelter for the payment of fifty cents (50¢) from each dog tax collected. This payment of fifty cents (50¢) from each dog tax collected by each Township Trustee be receipted to the County Auditor of Wabash County and he make the payment to the Wabash County Animal Shelter.
