GENERAL ORDINANCE 87-5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NON-SMOKING AND SMOKING AREAS IN THE BUILDING OF THE WABASH COUNTY COURTHOUSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 13-1-13-1 through 13-1-13-9 and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, as follows:

- There shall be no smoking, meaning the carrying of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or any other lighted smoking equipment, or the inhalation or exhalation of smoke from any lighted smoking equipment, in any of the offices, courtrooms, conference rooms, storage rooms, restrooms, or other areas of the Wabash County Courthouse except as designated and set out hereinafter;
- 2. Smoking as defined hereinabove shall be allowed in the hall of the basement level, hall of the first floor and hall of the second floor, and in the furnace room located in the basement of the Courthouse.
- Any one who violates this ordinance by smoking in any area other than the designated area, commits a Class C infraction.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the day of passing as set out hereinafter.
