## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 87-6

## AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING AND/OR ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR SANDY BEACH ESTATES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, State of Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq., and Indiana Code 9-4-1-58, and all acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined by engineering and traffic investigation that it would be in the best interest of the general public to set the speed zones at 30 miles per hour on Skyline Drive, Surf Drive, and Lakeside Drive in the subdivision of Sandy Beach Estates, Wabash County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana have considered these speed limits in conjunction with recommendations of a resident's committee for the subdivision heretofore named.

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erecting of appropriate signs on those portions of Wabash County roads located in Sandy Beach Estates named as follows, the maximum speed shall be 30 miles per hour;

- 1. Skyline Drive, maximum speed 30 m.p.h.
- 2. Surf Drive, maximum speed 30 m.p.h.
- Lakeside Drive, maximum speed 30 m.p.h.

Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction and shall be penalized appropriately. Any and all fines collected under this ordinance shall be deposited in the general fund of Wabash County, Indiana, under Indiana Code 9-4-1-27.
