GENERAL ORDINANCE 87-7

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS FOR SANDY BEACH ESTATES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, State of Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq., an Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control direction and intersection preferences should be established at certain intersections of Wabash County Road located in Sandy Beach Estate as follows, to-wit:

- 1. Intersection of Cardinal Drive and Lakeside Drive.
- 2. Lakeview Drive and Lakeside Drive.
- Pleasant View Drive and Lakeside Drive.
- 4. Surf Drive and Lakeside Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic preferences at the designated intersections in Sandy Beach Estate, Wabash County, Indiana, shall be as follows:

- At the intersection of Cardinal Drive and Lakeside Drive, being a T-intersection it shall be designated as a three (3) way stop and all trafffic approaching the intersection shall be required to stop before proceeding.
- .2. At the intersection of Lakeview Drive and Lakeside Drive, being a T-intersection it shall be designated as a three (3) way stop and all traffic approaching the intersection shall be required to stop before proceeding.
- 3. At the intersection of Pleasant View Drive and Lakeside Drive, being a T-intersection it shall be designated as a three (3) way stop and all traffic approaching the intersection shall be required to stop before proceeding.
- Surf Drive shall be required to stop for Lakeside Drive, making Lakeside Drive preferential at this intersection.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of appropriate signs at the locations as described herein.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction and shall be penalized appropriately. Any and all fines collected under this ordinance shall be deposited into the general fund of Wabash County, Indiana, under Indiana Code IC 9-4-1-27.
