GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-8

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND REVOCATION OF PRIOR ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that General Ordinance No. 83-4 passed by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County on May 16, 1983 should be abolished and that this ordinance shall now take its place.

WHEREAS, in so doing the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County are specifically and intentionally revoking General Ordinance No.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the passing of this General Ordinance traffic preferences at the intersection of County Road 100 West and 500 South and County Road 150 West and 500 South, which are county roads located in Wabash County, Indiana, shall be as follows:

- Road 500 South shall stop for Road 100 West.
- Road 150 West shall stop for Road 500 South.

The effect of this ordinance shall be to make County Road 500 South preferential at its intersection with 150 West and to make County Road 100 West preferential at its intersection with County Road 500 South.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction and shall be penalized appropriately. Any and all fines collected under this ordinance shall be deposited into the General Fund of Wabash County, Indiana under Indiana Code I.C. 9-4-1-27.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana.
