## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85- 9

## AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC

## CONTROL DEVICES AND REVOCATION OF PRIOR ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devises should be placed at a certain intersection of Wabash County roads as follows, to-wit:

(1) County Road 400 South shall stop for County Road 150 West.

WHEREAS, in so doing the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County are specifically and intentionally revoking any prior general ordinances wherein traffic control preferences were previously established at the intersecting roads as mentioned hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the passing of this General Ordinance and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic preference at the intersection of County Road 400 South and County Road 150 West, which are county roads located in Wabash County, Indiana, shall be as follows:

(1) County Road 400 South shall stop for County Road 150 West.

The affect of this ordinance shall be to make County Road 150 West preferential at its intersection with County Road 400 South.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction and shall be penalized appropriately. Any and all fines collected under this ordinance shall be deposited into the General Fund of Wabash County, Indiana, under Indiana Code I.C. 9-4-1-27.
