GENERAL ORDINANCE 84- 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE 84-5 WHICH ESTABLISHED MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FOR BRIDGES

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 17-2-2.5-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, did on the 16th day of April, 1984 pass General Ordinance 84-5 establishing the maximum safe weight levels on all bridges situated in Wabash County, Indiana,

AND WHEREAS, it has been determined that there needs to be included in that list of bridges the following described bridges as listed hereinafter,

AND WHEREAS, in so doing The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County are specifically and intentionally amending General Ordinance 84-5,

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the enactment of this ordinance amending General Ordinance 84-5 to include the following described bridges, the gross weight of vehicles using the following bridges situated within Wabash County, Indiana is now limited as follows:

| <u>State Bridge Number</u> | <u>County Number</u> | <u>Maximum Weight in Tons</u> |
|----------------------------|----------------------|-------------------------------|
| 101 | Noble 68 | 12 Ton |
| 116 | Noble 81 | 12 Ton |
| 137 | Liberty 45 | 10 Ton |
| 157 | Pleasant 33 | 10 Ton |

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of appropriate signs at the locations as described herein.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$1,000.00 to which may be added imprisonment in the Wabash County Jail for a period of not more than 90 days.
