

ORDINANCE NO. 83-2

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING POLICE RESERVES

Be it Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County,
Indiana THAT:

Section I

There is hereby established, pursuant to I.C. 36-8-3-29 the Wabash
County Police Reserves, which shall be known as the Wabash County
Sheriff's Reserve Unit.


Section II


The maximum number of members of said reserve unit shall be sixteen
(16) which are to be paid for their services from the budget of
Sheriff's Appropriations. There shall be granted the authority by
this ordinance, for additional members, those being either Matrons,
Jailers, Dispatchers and/or Process Server, who are not financially
reimbursed for services by this ordinance.


Section III
