

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 83- 6

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF  
TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices and intersection preferences should be established at certain intersections at Wabash County roads as follows, to-wit:

- 1. intersection of 400 West and 800 North.

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic preference at the intersection of County Road 400 West and 800 North shall be as follows:

- 1. Road 400 West shall stop for Road 800 North.

The effect of this ordinance shall be to make County Road 800 North preferential at its intersection with 400 West.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of appropriate signs at the locations as described herein.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to which may be added imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ten (10) days.
