

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 82-1

AN ORDINANCE TO ALTER TRAFFIC DEVICES


BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 17-2-2.5-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;


WHEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana have determined that it is in the best interest of safety that the yield signs for north and southbound traffic on County Road 400W at the intersection of County Road 400W and County Road 1300N, located four miles west and one mile north of the intersection of State Road 13 and State Road 114 in Pleasant Township should be replaced by stop signs to better control north and southbound traffic on County Road 400W.

NOW, THEREFORE, said yield signs for north and southbound traffic on County Road 400W at the intersection of County Road 400W and County Road 1300N shall be replaced with stop signs to control north and southbound traffic on County Road 400W.
