

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 80-5-

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE
PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control signs should be placed on Road 700 South at the intersection of the said Road 700 South with the Conrail railroad track,

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate stop signs, traffic moving in a northerly or southerly direction on the said Road 700 South shall be required to stop at the intersection of the said Road 700 South with the Conrail railroad track, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "B" Misdemeanor.
