GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 79-1

AND DIRECTING PLACEMENT OF SPEED ZONE SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it would be in the best interests of the general public to cause to be established speed zones on Wabash County Road 200N in the area of Metro-North School and Northfield High School, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that an appropriate speed limit for traffic on said road in those areas would be thirty-five (35) miles per hour,

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erecting of appropriate signs, on those portions of Wabash County Road 200N that are contiguous to the real estate owned by Metropolitan School District of Wabash County, Indiana, and upon which Metro-North School is situated and upon which Northfield High School is situated, the lawful maximum speed limit shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a class "B" misdemeanor.
