

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 78- I-A

AN ORDER DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT
OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices should be placed at the intersection of Wabash County Roads 200N and 300W,

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic moving in a northerly or southerly direction on County Road 300W shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 300W with County Road 200N, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so. Traffic moving in an easterly or westerly direction on County Road 200N shall not be required to stop at said intersection.

The effect of this ordinance is to establish County Road 200N as a preferential road at its intersection with County Road 300W, thereby causing traffic on said County Road 300W to stop and yield the right of way at the intersection of said Road with County Road 200N.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of stop signs on Wabash County Road 300W at its intersection with County Road 200N.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to which may be added imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ten (10) days.
