GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 7 , 1977

## AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF BOWMAN ROAD SITUATED IN WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA, that the following described portion of a public highway, commonly known as Bowman Road, and described more specifically as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the center of the intersection of Bowman Road and Werst Road, thence north seventy-four (74) degrees, twenty-four (24) minutes, thirty (30) seconds west a distance of one hundred seventy-one and five tenths (171.5) feet along the center line of Bowman Road

is now vacated and such right-of-way is now awarded to the abutting landowners.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
