## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 76-3 AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1, et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1, et. seq., and all Acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices should be placed at the intersection of County Road 350 East and County Road 50 South, and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices should be placed at the intersection of County Road 200 West and Division Road,

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic moving in an easterly direction on County Road 50 South shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 50 South with County Road 350 East and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so. Traffic moving in a southerly or northerly direction on County Road 350 East shall not be required to stop or yield right of way at said intersection.

FURTHER, traffic moving in an easterly or westerly direction on Division Road shall be required to stop at the intersection of said Division Road with County Road 200 West and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so. Traffic moving in a southerly or northerly direction on County Road 200 West shall not be required to stop or yield right of way at said intersection.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of appropriate signs at the locations described herein.



If a part of this Ordinance is adjudged to be invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid part shall remain in full force and effect.
