

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 4-1972
AN ORDINANCE CREATING STOP
INTERSECTIONS AND DIRECTING
PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Chapter 112, Acts of 1919, Chapter 48, Acts of 1939, Chapter 48, Acts of 1947, and Chapter 338, Acts of 1947, and all Acts amendatory thereto, General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined in conjunction with the Town Board of the Town of LaFontaine, Indiana, that certain traffic control devices need to be placed at the intersection of County Roads 1000 South and Old State Highway #15;

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, the intersection of County Road 1000 South with Old State Highway #15 shall be four-way stop intersections and all vehicles before entering said intersections shall stop and proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of stop signs at all corners at said locations.

If a part of this Ordinance is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.
