

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. I-A, 1970

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING INSTALLATION
AND MAINTENANCE OF AUTOMATIC TRAFFIC
CONTROL DEVICE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Chapter 112, Acts of 1919, Chapter 48, Acts of 1939, Chapter 48, Acts of 1947, and Chapter 338, Acts of 1947, and all Acts amendatory thereto:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has been requested to allow installation of automatic traffic signals to control the flow of traffic in both directions on the old Peru Road between the factory facilities and the parking area and the main office area of the United States Gypsum Company,

IT IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED, to install and maintain automatic traffic control lights at said places over and above the old Peru Road for the purpose of controlling vehicle traffic at the times when employees and personnel of said Company pass to and from the parking area of the Corporation to the factory area of said Corporation, and specifically for one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) hour before and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) hour after change of shifts each day, said signals to display red, yellow, and green lights during said period, and said signals to be timed so as to display a caution light at all other times.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that said control devices be maintained and operated in accordance with standards of the State of Indiana for such installation, and no cost shall accrue to

Wabash County, Indiana, or any other subdivision or part of the State of Indiana or Wabash County, Indiana.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.

If a part of this Ordinance is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.
