

**HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCE NUMBER 1, 1953**

State of Indiana )  
County of Wabash )  
Ordinance regulating vehicle parking in front of post-offices located on County Highways Section 1. Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County that the following regulations shall hereafter govern and apply to the parking of vehicles on county highways in Wabash County, to-wit:

(a) No vehicle shall be parked between the hours of 7:00 A. M. and 5:00 P. M. Central Standard Time on any week day in front of any building or premises used and occupied by the United States of America as and for a post office. The County Supervisor of Wabash County shall cause to be erected in front of each building or premises so used and occupied for Post Office purposes which are located on county highways, two suitable and permanent markers informing the public of these restrictions, one at each end of the space to be reserved from parking. The space reserved may be used, however, by official Post Office vehicles.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00 and not more than \$5.00, and costs; PROVIDED that no prosecution shall be instituted for a violation of SECTION 1 (a) unless markers shall have been installed and are in existence at the location where the alleged violation occurred at the time thereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect one week after publication.
