ORDINANCE NO. 85- 11- 2019

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(Old Slocum Trail speed limit)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the speed limit on Old Slocum Trail starting at a point eight hundred fifteen (815) feet east of its intersection with Old State Road 13 and continuing a distance of seven thousand, three hundred (7,300) feet to a point one thousand, two hundred feet (1,200) feet east of its intersection with County Road 100 West, should be forty-five (45) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The speed limit on Old Slocum Trail starting at a point eight hundred fifteen (815) feet east of its intersection with Old State Road 13 and continuing for a distance of seven thousand, three hundred (7,300) feet to a point one thousand, two hundred feet (1,200) feet east of its intersection with County Road 100 West is shall be forty-five (45) miles per hour.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
