ORDINANCE NO. 2020-85-03

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(Ireland Drive, from County Road 275 West extending east, speed limit)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, have determined that the speed limit on Ireland Drive between County Road 275 West extending east approximately three-tenths of a mile to an existing and unnamed cul-de-sac should be reduced to twenty (20) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The speed limit on Ireland Drive between County Road 275 West extending east approximately three-tenths of a mile to an existing and unnamed cul-de-sac shall be twenty (20) miles per hour.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
