ORDINANCE NO. 2020-85-04

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(Adjustment of speed limit on County Road 500 South, extending 1,925 feet east
from its intersection with County Road 50 East)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the speed limit on County Road 500 South, extending 1,925 feet east from its intersection with County Road 50 East, should be reduced to forty (40) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The speed limit on County Road 500 South, extending 1,925 feet east from its intersection with County Road 50 East, shall be forty (40) miles per hour.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
