ORDINANCE NO. 2020-85-7

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS

(Temporarily reducing the speed limit to 35 miles per hour on County Road 100 West, north from State Road 114 to County Road 1300 North, and on County Road 1300 North east from 100 West to Meridian Road)

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

At present, construction work on bridge #114-85-06653A is resulting in traffic being rerouted onto County Road 100 West and County Road 1300 North, causing heavier traffic on those highways than normal and necessitating a reduction of the speed limit on those county highways to maintain safety.

The Board of Commissioners has determined that the speed limit on County Road 100 West, north from State Road 114 to County Road 1300 North, and on County Road 1300 North east from 100 West to Meridian Road should be reduced to thirty-five (35) miles per hour for as long a construction continues on the bridge #114-85-06653A.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The speed limit on County Road 100 West, north from State Road 114 to County Road 1300 North, and on County Road 1300 North east from 100 West to Meridian Road is reduced to thirty-five (35) miles per hour for as long as construction continues on bridge # 114-85-06653A.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its publication as required by law.
