## ORDINANCE NO. 2025-85-15

## AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AUTHORITY TO SIGN COMMUNITY CROSSINGS MATCHING GRANT AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, Indiana's Home Rule statute (I.C. § 36-1-3 et. seq.) grants the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, all powers that are necessary to conduct the affairs of the County and the Board of Commissioners may adopt an ordinance prescribing a specific manner for exercising the power;

WHEREAS, the Community Crossings Matching Grant Program ("CCMG") is administered by the Indiana Department of Transportation and provides funding to local governmental units in Indiana to make improvements to local roads and bridges;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wabash, Indiana, has determined there is a need to designate the person(s) who have authority to sign CCMG applications and agreements on behalf of the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wabash, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Wabash, Indiana, is authorized to sign any and all applications and/or agreements necessary for or related to the CCMG, and the Chairman shall be considered the one official signatory that has legal authority to bind the County related to CCMG agreements.
- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the date of its adoption.
