RESOLUTION 2002- 3

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING: THAT SERVICES RENDERED BY VIRTUE OF AN IDEM GRANT APPLICATION FOR EQUIPMENT WILL NOT DISPLACE PRIVATE SECTOR SERVICES:

WHEREAS, Wabash County has provided Governmental Services of a nature requiring specified equipment, and,

WHEREAS, the specified equipment, a WOOD CHIPPER/SHREDDER, is needed for this continued and improved service, and,

WHEREAS, Wabash County (additional justification might include new safety issues, additional roads serviced, increased population, new initiatives, etc.)

WHEREAS, it is the finding of fact of the Wabash County Commissioners that this service will promote the public health, welfare, and safety of the residents of Wabash County, and, the Commissioners further determine through careful review and evaluation of all comments that the pursuit of this Grant will not significantly displace any private sector service of comparable scope and size, and, most importantly, will assist the State of Indiana in achieving its waste reduction goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, that:

- 1. The Commissioners authorize the preparation and submittal of an application for an Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) Source Reduction and Recycling Grant to support the roadside brush mulching efforts of the Wabash County Highway Department.
- 2. The Wabash County Highway Department commits the required resources as matching funds toward the purchase of the wood chipper/shredder in an amount up to \$ 23,758. Commitment of these funds is contingent upon receipt of the IDEM grant funding.
