RESOLUTION NO. 2012-85-03

A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS TO THE "RAINY DAY FUND" PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 36-1-8-5.1.

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-8-5.1 permits an Indiana county to establish a Rainy Day Fund to receive transfers of unused and unencumbered funds under said Indiana Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said statute, an Indiana County Council shall make a finding that the proposed use of the Rainy Day Fund is consistent with the intent of the fund before making an appropriation therefrom; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said statute, in any fiscal year an Indiana county may not transfer more than ten percent (10%) of its total budget for that fiscal year to the Rainy Day Fund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said statute, the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance may not reduce the actual or maximum permissible levy of an Indiana county as a result of a balance in the Rainy Day Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Therefore, effective this date, the Wabash County Council approves the transfer of \$ 691,406 of unused and unencumbered funds from 2011 in the County General Fund to the "Rainy Day Fund."
- 2. The "Rainy Day Fund" shall be subject to the same appropriation process as other funds that receive tax money.
- 4. The Wabash County Council hereby intends to utilize its decision-making power regarding fiscal affairs and set priorities for allocation and expenditure of the "Rainy Day Fund" as deemed necessary to best serve the residents of Wabash County.
