RESOLUTION OF HIGHWAY ACCEPTANCE

Whereas, Mill Creek Estates has been platted and approved as a sub-division to the County of Wabash by the Wabash County Plan Commission and the Wabash County Commissioners; and

Whereas, the County required from the developer, Roy Dunn, a good and sufficient bonding amount to assure correct and proper construction of Mill Creek Parkway, a hard surfaced road in Mill Creek Estates; and

Whereas, said contractor has completed all road constructions and appealed to the Commissioners to accept the roadway known as Mill Creek Parkway as a part of the Wabash County Highway system to include maintenance, repairs, clearing and any other regular county highway needs.

And the Wabash County Commissioners being duly and fully advised by the County Highway Superintendent that said road construction of Mill Creek Parkway has been in full compliance with county highway standards and specifications, does hereby accept Mill Creek Parkway as a part of the Wabash County Highway system assuming and undertaking therewith all responsibilities as consistent with any other roads in the Wabash County Highway system.

Further, by accepting said Mill Creek Parkway as a part of the county highway system there is no further need for the protection afforded by the bond amount placed by developer Roy Dunn prior to construction.


Wherefore, said bond and the full amount thereof previously placed by Roy Dunn is hereby released and directed to be returned to Roy Dunn.

Further, it is hereby resolved and directed that traffic on Mill Creek Parkway shall stop prior to crossing or entry onto County Road 400 South.


