RESOLUTION #2022-85-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF SOME CLAIMS PRIOR TO ALLOWANCE BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

I.C. 36-2-6-1, et seq., provides that the County Auditor may not pay a claim for which funds have been appropriated prior to its allowance by the Board of Commissioners at a regular or special meeting of the Board.

The County Auditor has made the Board of Commissioners aware of infrequent occasions in which the County may be assessed late fees and/or interest on a claim which the Auditor is unable to pay without prior allowance by the Board.

To avoid the assessment of late fees and/or interest on claims, the Board of Commissioners wishes to authorize the County Auditor to pay such claims without prior allowance by the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

In the event the non-payment of a claim for which funds have been appropriated may result in the assessment of late fees and/or interest, the County Auditor, after examining the merits of a claim and determining that it should be paid, may pay that claim without the prior allowance of the Board of Commissioners.

At the next regular or special meeting of the Board of Commissioners following the payment of such a claim, the County Auditor shall bring such claim to the attention of the Board for examination and determination.


