**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE WABASH COUNTY
MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Wabash County; and

WHEREAS the Wabash County Emergency Management Agency has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Wabash County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, June 2026, in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS Wabash County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, June 2026, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in (local government) from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and


WHEREAS adoption by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Wabash County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, June 2026.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

1. In accordance with Indiana Code 36-2-4, *et seq.*, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, adopts the Wabash County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, June 2026. While content related to Wabash County may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require Wabash County to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
