FEE CHARGES BY WHITE COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

1. Road Excavation / Cuts:
 - a. Gravel: \$10.00 per linear foot, except farm subsurface drain
Minimum \$200
 - b. Hard Surface: \$25.00 per linear foot
Minimum \$500
2. Plowing in Cable or Pipe: \$1.00 per linear foot; Minimum \$100
3. Directional Boring: \$1.00 per linear foot; Minimum \$100
4. Trenching / Excavating (adjacent to roadway): \$1.00 per linear foot; Minimum \$100
5. Horizontal Boring or Pushing Under Roadway: \$150.00 per bore (Total cost per Location).
*****Vertical Boring in road or right-of-way allowed only with Commissioner Approval***

6. Pole Lines: \$1,250.00 per mile, or minimum of \$100.00 per pole
7. Setting Structures (above and below ground, including pedestals, splicer box, junction box and transformers but not including poles): \$200.00 per structure
8. Temporary Construction or Access Roads: \$250.00 each
9. Weight Permit Fees to be calculated:
 - a. 80,000 lbs – 100,000 lbs:
 - i. \$50,000 Bond; and
 - ii. \$50.00 per axel
 - b. 100,001 lbs – 200,000 lbs:
 - i. \$50,000 Bond; and
 - ii. Fee of (0.0005) multiplied by (weight in pounds) multiplied by (# of axels)
 - c. 200,001 lbs and over:
 - i. \$100,000 Bond;
 - ii. Fee of (0.0005) multiplied by (weight in pounds) multiplied by (# of axels); and
 - iii. Road Use Agreement approved by White County Commissioners and White County Surveyor. Contact White County Attorneys to schedule meeting.
10. Frost Law – February 1st through May 1st of each year:

Projects during Frost Law shall submit a Bond in the doubled amount of Section 9 above.

11. Testing Permit: \$50.00 minimum

In accordance with the Schedule of Fees, a check in the amount of \$_____ is attached.

A bond as required pursuant to Ordinance 20-12-28-01, as may be amended, shall be filed prior to applicant's opening or damage, and shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from the date of completion of said work. A Standard Bond Form shall be used and Bond shall be made payable to the Board of Commissioners of White County, Indiana.

I HEREBY AGREE: If the inside face of trench is within three (3) feet of the edge of the road surface, I agree:

1. To back fill the trench of the said opening with bank run gravel or crushed stone, which will be thoroughly compacted by tamping in layers not to exceed four (4) inches in depth to within twelve (12) inches of the present surface;
2. To dispose of all surplus material;
3. To replace the remaining twelve (12) inches within the trench opening as per conditions existing prior to making trench, except that portion of the trench which is in the traveled road, the remaining twelve (12) inches will be backfilled with coarse gravel or crushed stone, maintained in a smooth and uniform condition for a period of not less than four (4) weeks after traffic is allowed to pass over the filled trench, until such time the surface shall be replaced to existing conditions unless otherwise provided by special provisions.

I FURTHER AGREE:

To furnish a drawing showing size, type, controlling dimensions, etc. of the proposed improvement relative to existing pavement, existing structures, existing right-of-way, and existing utilities;

To erect and maintain all necessary barricades, detour signs and warning lights, as set out in Section D of the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, to safely direct traffic over and around that part of the road where the above-described work is to be done, so long as the work in any way interferes with traffic;

To move or remove any structures installed under this permit, should future traffic conditions or road improvements necessitate and when requested to do so by the White County Highway Superintendent.

I ACKNOWLEDGE:

If, in completing the project, any action is taken on the surface other than specified on this application, additional amounts may be charged by the White County Highway Department. Damages may be assessed at the rate of \$365,000 per mile of paved road, and \$160,000 per mile of chip and seal road.

Any project requiring a Road Use Agreement shall be given no less than Seventy-Two (72) hours notice to the White County Highway Superintendent prior to initiation of work, in compliance with Indiana Statutory Notice requirements.

GRANT OF PERMIT TO CUT INTO WHITE COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY

The White County Highway Superintendent hereby grants to _____

a permit to cut into the White County Highway Right of Way described herein, on the condition that said applicant file with White County a Bond made payable to the Board of Commissioners of White County in the amount of \$_____. This permit shall expire one (1) year from the date of issuance, unless work has begun on location.

This permit is not effective until the Bond is filed.

If any person shall install a pipeline, conduit or private drain across or along any County Highway, or shall block or damage a portion of County Road, without first obtaining a permit herein and filing the required Bond, such person may be in violation of State and Federal statute subject to civil and criminal penalties.
