Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Cynthia J. Ayers, Judge of Marion Superior Court 4, notified this Court that she would be retiring on March 15, 2024. Senior Judge David A. Shaheed has expressed a willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in Marion Superior Court 4 beginning on April 8, 2024.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge David A. Shaheed is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Marion Superior Court 4, effective April 8, 2024, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Shaheed to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of Marion Superior Court 4 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Shaheed shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
