Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Dale W. Arnett, Judge of the Randolph Superior Court, has notified this Court that he will be taking a leave of absence beginning April 27, 2025. Senior Judge Kimberly S. Dowling has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Randolph Superior Court beginning on April 28, 2025.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Kimberly S. Dowling is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Randolph Superior Court, effective April 28, 2025, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Dowling to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Randolph Superior Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Dowling shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
