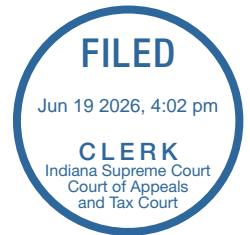

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Jay L. Toney, Judge of the Randolph Circuit Court, has notified this court that he will be retiring July 6, 2026. Senior Judge Kimberly S. Dowling has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Randolph Circuit Court beginning on July 6.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Kimberly S. Dowling is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Randolph Circuit Court, effective July 6, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Dowling to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Randolph Circuit Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Dowling shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
