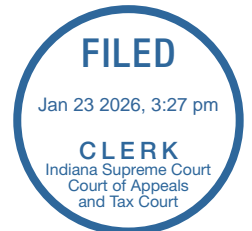

## Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Steven P. Meyer, Judge of the Tippecanoe Superior Court 2, has notified this court that he is taking a leave of absence. Senior Judge John D. Potter has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Tippecanoe Superior Court 2, beginning on January 27, 2026.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Potter is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Tippecanoe Superior Court 2, effective January 27, 2026, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Potter to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of Tippecanoe Superior Court 2 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Potter shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
