## Order

Appellant, by counsel, filed a motion to transmit separately filed exhibits asking the Court to transmit the record of proceedings in his post-conviction appeal (49S00-0409-PD-420) and his direct appeal (49S00-0011-DP-638) into case number 24S-SD-342.
