Order

On February 18, 2025, the Court issued an order scheduling this case for a forty-minute oral argument on Thursday, June 5 at 9:00 a.m. Appellee has moved to extend the argument time. In support, Appellee asserts that: (1) when the Court ordered oral argument, it also sua sponte invited the participation of amici curiae; and (2) Appellee has agreed to allocate five minutes of its oral argument time to amici curiae, Indiana Builders Association, Inc. and Associated Builders and Contractors of Indiana/Kentucky.
