## Order Extending and Expanding the Civil Case Management Pathways Pilot Project

On May 19, 2023, this Court issued an order establishing the Civil Case Management Pathways Pilot Project for a term not to exceed two years, beginning with cases filed on June 1, 2023. The purpose of the Pilot Project is to decrease the amount of time until case disposition, significantly reduce discovery disputes, allow judges to spend more time on complicated issues, and increase the satisfaction of court users. The Pilot Project uses a pathway assignment system to achieve right-sized case management to best align court management practices and resources.

The Civil Case Management Pathways Pilot Project term is hereby EXTENDED until December 31, 2026 to expand the Pilot Project to more counties across the State and to gather additional data. All terms governing the Pilot Project included in the May 19, 2023 order and Exhibit A, which was attached to that order, shall remain in effect during the extension period.
