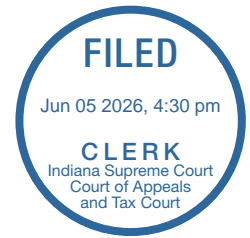




Order Appointing Member to the Board of Law Examiners
